Two start-up businesses emerged from the Watts Entrepreneur Business Accelerator (WEBA) program, hiring five residents from the greater Watts community. Macedonia CDC is helping businesses to create jobs.

Our Community Service pillar established a three-year partnership with the Beth Shir Shalom Progressive Reform Synagogue's Big Sunday Project. Macedonia CDC and Beth Shir Shalom come together for community clean-up activities adjacent to the Watts Serenity Park and have diverted more than five (5) tons of trash and refuse from local landfills since 2015.
